The All-Pardoning.




























Allah Al 'Afuw will pardon our sins by wiping it away from our Book of Records and from our minds.








We can be disturbed and embarrassed if we are reminded of our wrongs, but our relationship with Allah is so easy.

And we should accept all that comes to us, what is given to us and the people.








We always want Allah to pardon us and when He pardons us, it will be so easy.

قلت: يا رسول الله أرأيت إن علمت أي ليلة القدر ما أقول فيها؟ قال: "قولي: " اللهم إنك عفو تحب العفو فاعف عنى"

I asked: "O Messenger of Allah (صلى الله عليه وسلم) If I realize Lailat-ul-Qadr (Night of Decree), what should I supplicate in it?" He replied, "You should supplicate:

Allahumma innaka 'afuwwun, tuhibbul-'afwa, fa'fu 'anni

(O Allah, You are All-Pardoning, and love to pardon; so pardon me)."


