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
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
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


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Etiquettes of Making Dua

Chapter 6

الرقية الشرعية | Ruqyah

Ruqyah is a method for healing through some parts of the Qur'an and Sunnah of the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم).

The Qur'an is a cure for all diseases.


Healing can be for diseases, sicknesses of the heart (arrogance, showing off, hatred, jealousy) and loneliness.



SURAH AL FATIHA

"In the name of Allah - the Entirely Merciful, the Especially Merciful. Guide us to the straight path - the path of those upon whom You have bestowed favor, not of those who have evoked [Your] anger or of those who are astray."

Lay not on us a burden like that which You did lay on those before us. Our Lord! Put not on us a greater burden than we have strength to bear. Pardon us and grant us forgiveness. Have mercy on us. You are our Protector, and help us against the disbelieving people.” (Al-Baqarah, 2:285-286)
