### and the religious scholars and seekers of knowledge."

- When we do not say subhan Allah, we will only think negative.
- When we do not say alhamdulilah, we will praise ourselves or others.
- When we do not say Allahu Akbar, we will exalt the problems or ourselves.
- When we do not say la ilaah ila Allah, we will attach to what is less than Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- When we know we are here for only a temporary time, then we will remember that we are in this life as if we are a stranger or traveler. We are all strangers in this life, but what will make the feeling remain? When we remember Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

- It is a blessing when Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) reforms us, but we should say, "glory be to Your Lord".

- In the story of Musa (عليه السلام) and Al Khidr, one of the signs of the meeting point is the fish which Musa (عليه السلام) and his servant boy had eaten would be brought back to life, it would go back into the water, and Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will make the sea still so only the fish can be seen, subhan Allah.

But when they reached the junction between them, they forgot their fish, and it took its course into the sea, slipping away.

- When Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) wants to show ayat, He will make everything still so that we only see that nurturing from Him. So the nurturing of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is to make everything still in order to see that movement.
- Not everyone in our house will seek knowledge, but everyone in our house will be placed in the decree. And the one with knowledge has to submit to the decree. And similarly, Musa (عليه السلام) had full knowledge of the book, he knew all the rules and legislations. But Al Khidr (عليه السلام) had knowledge of the decree, but he did not

- have knowledge of the book, rules and legislation.
- we are in this life as a traveler and anyone can teach us a lesson. We should never think, "I know and they don't know" because it is Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) Who can send anyone to us to teach us.
- Honor is with Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and how He nurtures us, so alhamdulilah Rabb Al 'Alameen (all praises are due to Allah, Lord of the Worlds).

#### LIVE WITH THE QUR'AN -SURAH AAL IMRAAN

- In paradise, we will have gardens, we will be there forever, all spouses will be purified and there is the pleasure of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- While we are in this life, we have to have taqwa, and in order to get paradise, we need to not follow our desires. When we put down something, we end up highlighting ourselves.
- The place of taqwa is in the heart, and whoever has taqwa, then a way out will be made for him.

### SURAH AAL IMRAAN 16 الَّذِينَ يَقُولُونَ رَبَّنَا إِنَّنَا آمَنَّا فَاغْفِرْلَنَا ذُنُوبَنَا وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Those who say, "Our Lord, indeed we have believed, so forgive us our sins and protect us from the punishment of the Fire,"

- (النَّذِينَ يَقُولُونَ رَبَّنَا إِنَّنَا آمَنَا) (Those who say, "Our Lord, indeed we have believed,): belief means something we do not see, but we believe in our Nurturer because He is perfect.
- o forgive us our sins): when we truly believe in the One Who is perfect, we will ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to forgive our sins.
- Sins take us backwards while seeking forgiveness takes us forward. We make mistakes in life, so that we are humble and go forward.
- وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ) و (and protect us from the punishment of the Fire,"): we ask Allah (سبحانه ) to protect us from the fire and this means

to be protected from any sins that can take us to the fire.

So we not only want forgiveness, but protection as well. And both are outlets in this life for taqwa.
