



- We all want the best life, but what does that mean? It means we want to enjoy the provision we have. We want our eyes to enjoy seeing the provision. We want our ears to enjoy hearing the provision. And we want our heart to be grateful for the provision.
- Our life will not be "a life" if we do not highlight Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) in our life. Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al Qadeer, He is Al Hayy Al Qayyoom and He is Ar Razzaaq Dhul Quwata Al Mateen He is the All-Able, The Ever-Living, The Self-Sustaining Master, The Provider, The Most Strong.

- We should never be deceived with our ability or power. The power we have is the power of faith and seeking the help of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) created us, fashioned us, provides us and sustains us in a perfect measure not more or less. The state we are in at this moment is the best decree. We need to look at ourselves, where we are and the environment around us everything is the best and most excellent because every decree is valuable.
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) does not give us more to be excessive and does not give less to be deprived or to panic.
- It is important to begin with contentment and satisfaction. Even our limited mind and brain

- might tell us, "why do they have and not me?", and if we do this, we will lose the essence of life.
- Anything which Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) brings to us is the best for us, for what? So that we believe in Him, highlight Him and flee to Him.
- ال It is important to believe in the power of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) because this is what will make us confident, why? Because we are living with Allah Al Qadeer, so surely He will decree the best decrees for us. We do not believe in our ears or eyes, knowledge or experience, but believe in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- If we believe in Allah Al Qadeer, it will solve 100% of our problems. The moment we think we have power, we will be stressed and panic. The moment we think someone is able, we will be restless.

- However, we want to be an honored slave, waiting from their Master to not only be given food, but the best food; not to be taught any knowledge, but exclusive knowledge. The more we trust Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), the more He will show us of His beauty.
- Ihsaan is not about following our desires or expectations or what people think of us. We think desire is only about going towards the haram, but desire is to be stubborn on what we think. However, when there ihsaan, we will see Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and will always be excited.
- To Live with Allah Al Qadeer will not make us someone stubborn, snatching or to say "this is mine" because Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is The Distributor of Provision. We want to be an

- obedient slave waiting for their Master and what He will bring to us today.
- We want to have provisions of different feelings towards Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and not just different foods and drinks. When we accept any situation in our life, then Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will show us so much, though it is just a moment of submission.
- The strength and power of faith is when we are able to surrender and submit, to take whatever Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) has given us, and to take the reminders from whatever and whomever it comes.
- Whatever provision Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) brings to us is customized and exactly for us, so we will feel rich and satisfied and not look around, imitate

or feel restless. With Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), He will give us customized protection and customized provision.

- When we believe in Allah Al Qadeer, He will give us the power of submission and the power of running to Him, and not the power of running behind others. However, if we are stubborn and only go around our desires then we will be unable to see the blessings and have feelings for Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- Allah Al Qadeer gives us the ability to be flexible, accommodating and gentle in a time when there is darkness, conflict and struggle.
- Belief in the Name of Allah Al Qadeer solves many issues and conflict of the people due to provision.

- Examples of provision (rizq) are knowledge, food, drinks, a smile, love, husband, food, clothing, children, feelings, money and time.
- Provision is important because it benefits us, but there can be arguments due to jealousy. Jealousy is a burning feeling in the heart, | why do they have and not me?", but what should be done, to believe Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the Provider and He gives according to His perfect knowledge and wisdom.
- People become proud or associate another partner with Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) just so they may be be provided.
- Eighting and arguments between people are all due to provision. So what is the solution? To believe that Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al Qadeer and He will give everyone the right measure.

- o Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the Provider and Distributor,

 He is the Bestower, and the angels carry out

 the command of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- o Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the One Who distributes the provision, so we should not say, "why do they get and not me?".
- People think justice is equality, but justice is what is suitable for each person. For example, people are different with different needs, and each gets what is needed for each, and Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) knows what is the best provision for each.
- During the time of the Prophet (ﷺ), they said that he distributed the booty unjustly, so he said, "if the Messenger of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is not fair, then who will be fair?"

DISTRIBUTION OF THE SPOILS

Upon this the Ansar said: It is strange that our swords are dripping with their blood, whereas our spoils have been given to them (to the Quraish). This (remark) reached the Messenger of Allah (*), and so he gathered them and said: What is this that has been conveyed to me about you? They said: (Yes) it is that very thing that, has reached you and they were not (the people) to speak a lie. Upon this he said: Don't you like that the people should return to their houses along with worldly riches, whereas you should return to your houses with the Messenger of Allah? If the people were to tread a valley or a narrow path, and the Ansar were also to tread a valley or a narrow path, I would tread the valley (along with the) Ansar or the narrow path (along with the) Ansar.4

- The Prophet (ﷺ) reminded them of the favor of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and he said, some people will return with money and cattle, but you will return with the Prophet (ﷺ).
- And this shows to have companionship, love and feelings are a greater provision than just something worldly. There can be divorce and

- conflict for worldly matters and all the feelings are forgotten.
- We are humans made of flesh who have feelings, we appreciate smiles and love from one another, more than anything worldly.
- People separate due to worldly matters because of place, position and why did he get and not me, but in the end it is all "duniya" which means it is something low. We do not want to fight for something low and then forget happiness and forget a smile, guidance, knowledge and love.
- When people die, people will not remember what they had, but they will remember the feelings they showed. And why do we wait until someone passes away to remember the feelings? Subhan Allah.

- Worldly provision and tasks can be distributed, shared and taken by others, but feelings cannot be inherited and carried over. Who will tell someone we love them after we die?
- <u>Believers</u> are content and do their best by taking whatever Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) brings them because they know whatever Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) brings is nurturing.
- It is not about running behind provision or feeling bad someone took and not me. We want to be honored, do our best and take everything with a good heart.
- Regarding ihsaan, is it based on what others have or what we have? It is whatever Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) gives us and that is best for us. Our excellence (ihsaan) is best in whatever Allah

(سبحانه وتعالى) has provided us and not what others have.

o Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al Hayy Al Qayyoom and His life is perfect and not ours. Our life will be perfect when we attach to Him alone and He is Al Qayyoom to maintain our life.

- Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) does not need us, but we need Him so we should not feel proud of our money, position, worship or knowledge. Everything is Allah's favor on us in order to bring us closer to Him, to purify us and to honor us.
- olid not expect to have a اعليه السلام) did not expect to have a knowledgeable son but received glad tiding

- when he was old and his wife was barren. And before that time, he was busy hosting and entertaining the guests at the end of his life.
- We think he is the father of the prophets and must be giving sermons, but is accommodating others, opening his house and giving food. And Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) gave us a knowledgeable son. And this shows Messengers need the most nurturing, though we may think they are complete.
- و Just as Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) distributes provision tailor-made for us, He will extract tailor-made worships from us.
- Everyone is beautiful when they remember Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and accept what He has given them. When we believe in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and believe provision is from Him, then He will

- enlarge it for us and make our "sky" and "ceiling" vaster.
- When we were small, our ceiling was limited with wanting to eat happy meal and go to the play area, but as we grow, our "ceiling" becomes higher.

- We want to believe and trust in Allah's vastness and how He will make things easy for us on this earth. We want to be in life as someone who submits, accepts and is revived and alive when believing in Allah Al Hayy Al Qayyoom.
- We want to be someone confident and not someone who runs behind the duniya. We want to focus on the job Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) created us for because it is beautiful.

- We want to enjoy the blessings, be grateful for it and we do not want our provision to be discontinued; we want it to be established and continuous, how?
- As long as we continue our path to Allah (وتعالى) and not look at what others have or have a grudge against them, then He will grant us continuous provision because we are fulfilling our purpose. Let us take the opposite, if there is any kind of conflict or disconnection, then it will be cut-off.

- Our provision can be also on hold due to shirk because shirk will cut off all connections. However, Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will never give up on us. If there is shirk in our heart, then He will purify us so that we can get back on track and receive continuous provisions from Him.
- Shirk is when we think someone else will provide us or we argue about provision, but we want a constant supply of love, feelings and mercy.

- When we run behind anyone for provision, the path will only become narrow and crooked, and we will become tight and cannot enjoy our role. But when we return and flee to Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) then there is expansion and ease.
- We are not created to fight for provision or to only eat and drink. We are created to enjoy the blessings from Allah (سبحانه وتعالی), enjoy worshiping Him and expressing our love, hope and fear to Him. And He will provide us because He does not need anything from us.
- If some kind of provision is discontinued, it is replaced with another provision or from another channel, so there is a constant supply of provision from Allah (سبحانه وتعالى); it is never "out of stock".

We want Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to be our Companion because He will show us His beauty and richness. And that is when we negate the power, ability and knowledge of anyone – and firmly believe in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). This is (لا إله الا الله)
