- When there is a lofty goal and purpose, we will know that the journey to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is not by feet, but by heart.
- "Madarij As Salikeen" is a beautiful book which reflects upon the worships of heart on the path to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- It begins by mentioning Surah Al 'Asr because we do not want to lose and then it mentions Surah Al Fatiha because it is an opening, curer, sufficient for us and a connection.
- We are all travelers in this life; we are not permanent residents here. We are travelling to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and this travel is not based on

our might and power, but to travel with our heart.

LOFTY GOALS IN SURAH AL FATIHA

TO KNOW WHO IS THE ONE WORTHY OF WORSHIP

Previously we defined Who is The One we worship, and that He is Allah, Ar Rabb, Ar Rahman, and we always praise Him because He is The Lord of the Worlds and He is The Most Merciful, The Especially Merciful.

2. CONFIRMATION WE WILL RETURN TO ALLAH

Whether we accept our nurturing or not, this abode is the abode of deeds and not the abode of recompense because there will be a Day when we will return to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

SURAH AL FATIHA 4

مَالِكِ يَوْمِ الدِّين

Sovereign of the Day of Recompense.

- $_{ ilde{ }^{\circ}}$ This ayah confirms that we will return to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and meet Him.
- This life is not the time for judgement and recompense. If Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is not judging us or recompensing us in this life, so who are we do to this?
- A person must first fulfill all the decrees in his life, exit this life, enter the barzakh and then be resurrected when the judgement will take place.
- It is not for us to account and judge, Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) is Al Haseeb and He is All-Wise in the judgement.
- Alhamdulilah only Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the Owner of the Day of Recompense and consequently the Owner of this life, so we are not the ones to

judge. Knowing this cures us from any types of sicknesses of the heart.

- Everyone needs to think of that return and meeting with Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), and not to think of getting our reward and judgement in this life.
- Everyone will return in the hereafter at the same time, unlike in this life where everyone enters and exits in different times.
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al Maalik, The Owner so we cannot judge anyone, and the Day of Judgement is called Yawm Ad Deen (يَوْم اللِّين)
 - The Day of Recompense and Debt when everyone will be recompensed according to what they fulfilled or did not fulfill in this life.
- When we know we will be recompensed, rewarded or punished in the hereafter then we should not wait for it in this life.

3. Confirmation of messengers

- We find direct and indirect evidence in Surah
 Al Fatiha about the messengers.
- We cannot be in this life without messengers to show us how to practice the religion. If there are no messengers then people will be misled and follow whatever they want to follow. So messengers are a mercy to mankind.

SURAH AL FATIHA 2

الْحَمْدُ لِللهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ

[All] praise is [due] to Allah, Lord of the worlds

Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) is the Nurturer of all the worlds by providing them and guiding them. So surely Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) will not leave His slaves without sending them righteous messengers that will teach the people what is good for them and

tell them to stay away from what will harm them.

- This ayah confirms that Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will never leave the people without guiding them and the best way of guidance is through the messengers who are role models for the people. We will look into this further in the next class in sha'a Allah.
- In conclusion, we see the great depth and importance of knowing Surah Al Fatiha and the lofty goals it pertains.
