You cause the night to enter the day, and You cause the day to enter the night; and You bring the living out of the dead, and You bring the dead out of the living. And You give provision to whom You will without account."

We can get provision with hisaab (account) and without hisaab, but we all desire without hisaab – with no account. When people do not know this, they become upset and sad when they see others have and not them. But knowing Allah Al Haseeb (The Reckoner) resolves this.

ALLAH AL HASEEB (الحسيب) – THE RECKONER

- when we know Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al Haseeb (The Reckoner), we will deal with Him with no restriction or account. People think strength is when we calculate, expect and estimate, but Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is above all expectations. There will be no mistakes from Allah Al Haseeb.
- He accounts all situations and He accounts all feelings behind all words. When we know that

we cannot account any of this, then why do we account others? Subhan Allah. Why do we tell others, "why did you say this word to me?" or "I know the look in your eye meant this", subhan Allah.

- Allah Al Haseeb also means the One Who is enough and sufficient for us. Our head spins when we do not understand certain talk or certain behavior or are exposed to too much information or we do good and receive bad, so we get confused. Allah ("Files and accounts" are with Him and He is worthy of accounting us.
- The angels record our deeds, but they do not judge. For example, we may have access to

- numbers, but we cannot do anything with it, so someone comes to analyze them.
- We may learn something and we apply it on our first child, but when we apply on our second, it doesn't work. And this is to show that we cannot depend on our expectations and calculations, but depend on Allah Al Haseeb Who takes in to account of everything.
- Or we find a great amount of data being gathered, or if we speak a word, we see an ad comes about it on our phone, so people account to sell, market and monitor. But Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) accounts us for our benefit.
- Even when start a business or build a home or start anything, we need numbers. But we need to trust Allah Al Haseeb and His

- accounting and not ours, and know that He provides us with no account.
- Before practicing Islam, it is important to know Who is Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) because He is the One Who set the deen as Islam.
- The other meaning of Allah Al Haseeb is He is Sufficient for us. He is enough for us with His mercy. He is enough for us with His love. He is enough for us with His generosity. And He will provide us with no account,
- Another meaning of Allah Al Haseeb is The One Who will account us on the Day of Judgement. We cannot account the people because we do not know everything. For example, we may study for hours and end up still failing our exam. And the teacher will not consider how much effort we put in our

- studies, but only the final result. Though Allah Al Haseeb will not only look at the final result, but all we did and the effort we placed.
- Someone might think if Allah is Al Haseeb and He accounts everything and He is sufficient, then we do not need to do anything, but we must do something. We also have a choice.

- We must believe and do good deeds. When Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) says He is The Most Merciful then we must seek His mercy. When He says He is near then we must invoke Him and draw near to Him.
- There is the Will of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), but we also have free will. In the story of Firaoun, he was scared for his kingship, so he killed all the young boys, but the mother threw Musa (عليه) in the river. Someone might think she did not think this through, but this was no hisaab, and he was saved.
- The Will of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is based on His knowledge and wisdom. Bad people can have kingdom and good people can have kingdom. Bad people can have honor and

good people can have honor. This is the Will of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) based on His perfect knowledge and wisdom.

Have you not considered the one who argued with Abraham about his Lord [merely] because Allah had given him kingship? When Abraham said, "My Lord is the one who gives life and causes death," he said, "I give life and cause death." Abraham said, "Indeed, Allah brings up the sun from the east, so bring it up from the west." So the disbeliever was overwhelmed [by astonishment], and Allah does not guide the wrongdoing people.

- Namrud had kingship but he was a disbeliever. This is the Will of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), but it is based on His wisdom. We see how Ibrahim (عليه السلام) challenged him, but he was arrogant, and in the end, Namrud died by having a fly inside his head. This fly irritated him until his death, we ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) for the well-being. Ameen.
- و Yusuf (عليه السلام) was given position after all the trials he went through, and firmness is to believe in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) in every decree.

 And not to react according to how we want.

They wanted a king and it was not Talut who killed Jalut, but the one whom they did not choose, Dawud (عليه السلام). He was the one

who defeated Jalut, and this is the Will of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

- Dawud (عليه السلام) had a beautiful voice, he could mold iron and chains, he had judgement, he was the best worshipper, fasting every other day, and he would eat only from what he earns.
- <u>o</u> Knowing Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Maalik Al Mulk keeps us connected, but if we believe this is mine and not hers, then this separates us.
- We do not own what earth we walk on, what food we eat and the people we come across
 only Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Maalik Al Mulk. We only own our faith and good deeds.
- People can be very possessive, but knowing Allah Maalik Al Mulk frees us. And when we have position or authority, we should not look

at ourselves, but look at Allah Al Maalik because just as He gave us, He can take it away from us. And if we see anyone with position, we have to know Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Maalik Al Mulk.
