### عش مع الله العليم LIVE WITH ALLAH AL 'ALEEM – THE ALL-KNOWER

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### INTRODUCTION

- When we taste the enjoyment of loving Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) then everything will be beautiful. There is no one like Him and He is able to do all things. Paradise is in my heart and that is with the remembrance of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). We can overcome any problems when our heart turns to Him.
- The highest level of knowledge is "I do not know, but Allah knows." Someone can be ignorant and not know, so if they say, "I do not

know" then they truly do not know. But someone who was taught by Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) by the book and has knowledge and experience, and says "I do not know, Allah knows" shows humility.

- When we know things and we can easily depend on what we know and not turn to the perfect knowledge of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- It is important to deal with Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), even if we know all the processes and ways, by emptying ourselves from any knowledge that we have. (لا إله الا الله) is to deny our knowledge, despite having knowledge, and attributing it totally to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- Allah is Ar Rafeeq, He is The Most Gentle Companion and will always accompany us in

- every moment of our life. He will not take us to one stage and then let us go.
- He is so subtle with us such that He will not rush us in order to purify us or upgrade us. He will accompany us every step of the way, even if we need longer time.

# NAME OF ALLAH AL 'ALEEM IN SURAH AL BAQARAH

and He is so forbearing with us. In life, the more a person has knowledge and experience, the more they can be hasty with others. For example, someone may be experiencing something for the first time, and someone else who has gone through it will say, "it's nothing,"

move on", though this is rushing and will not give space for the first person to express what they feel or show emotions. As a result, it becomes an unnatural nurturing.

- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will teach us more about Himself when we are an obedient slave while in His decree. The Name of Allah Al 'Aleem will quieten our life from excessive talk, anxiety and worries.
- We are not here in this life to be perfect, but with the Names of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), He will perfect us and fill our gaps.
- We can be so stressed when we have an overload of information, and when we face a situation, it becomes difficult to recall what to say or do due to the many bits of information floating in our mind. But when we say, "Allah

knows and I don't know", what will happen?
Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will teach us something we do
not know and no one else knows.

### SURAH AL 'ALAQ 5

### عَلَّمَ الْإِنسَانَ مَا لَمْ يَعْلَمْ

Taught man that which he knew not.

- He will teach us about His beauty and perfection, He will teach us how to love Him and have feelings for Him. No one can teach us to have feelings for Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) except Him.
- When we believe Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is Al 'Aleem and He is The Most Gentle and Subtle Companion then He will teach us and show us in the right time.
- Allah Al 'Aleem knows what situations and what words will trigger us and make us know

our reality. And the best reality to know about ourselves – it is to know that we are a slave of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). Our mother, our father are all slaves of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). We have to go through the decrees written for us and this will make us submit and be a real slave.

- Every time Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will make us discover something about ourselves. Before Covid, we thought something about ourselves and then after Covid, we learned more about ourselves. And when we accept the decree, Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will show us more. May Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) make us know ourselves in the way pleasing to Him. Ameen.
- We want to know ourselves as a slave of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) who is humble and empties

themselves from attaching to anyone except Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

- Sometimes we wonder how is it possible to have a good life, but each Name of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will make us have a good life.
- It is important to not come into a matter as if we already know. For example, everyone wants to be the first to know what's happening and if we tell them something, they say, "Oh, I already know." One of the scholars said if someone comes to tell me a hadith, though I know it before they were even born, I will listen to them. And this shows so much humility.
- We can easily depend on our knowledge or the knowledge of others. For example, we may cook something and it comes out great. And when someone tells us to make the same dish

again, we depend on ourselves that we already know, and when we make it again, it comes out differently. And this is all to show "Allah knows and we do not know".

Our life will change the moment our heart turns and believes "Allah knows and I do not know."

### SURAH AL BAQARAH 256

There shall be no compulsion in [acceptance of] the religion. The right course has become clear from the wrong. So whoever disbelieves in Taghut and believes in Allah has grasped the most trustworthy handhold with no break in it.

And Allah is Hearing and Knowing.

- The scholars were so humble and they were not ashamed to say, "I do not know" when they do not.
- It is important to not attribute knowledge to ourselves. In the story of Qaroon, he was from the people of Musa (عليه السلام) who was very wealthy, but he made a statement that brought him down. When asked how he had many treasures, he said, "I have attained it due to my knowledge". Due to this statement, Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) caused him to sink.

### SURAH AL QASAS 78 TO 81

And We caused the earth to swallow him and his home. And there was for him no company to aid him other than Allah, nor was he of those who [could] defend themselves.

- Whatever knowledge we have, whether knowledge of book or experience, we should never show-off or judge. We should never depend or rely on our knowledge. We should only ask Allah (سبحانه وتعانى), "You know and I do not know".
- Knowledge is a trial because it can place a person in a position where he sees himself as powerful, even as a "god". No matter how much knowledge we have, we should not use

- it to judge others or categorize the people and what their final outcome will be.
- In this hadith we are told about someone who judged another for the sin they committed and said, "Allah will not forgive them", what happened?

### DO NOT JUDGE OTHERS

- Knowledge needs a great amount of purification. We have to purify our heart and soul because knowledge can easily make us take on a position where we will exceed our boundaries.
- Musa (عليه السلام) had a great amount of knowledge, but he was impatient in the decree. It is important to be patient and accept the decree in order to not fall into a trial. We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to protect us from all trials apparent and hidden. Ameen.
- It is important to believe that Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) knows and we do not know because that is protection for us. With the Name of Allah Al 'Aleem, it will help us from falling into traps, sins and faults.

- For example, we may be walking but we do not know there is a hole ahead, so what will happen? We will fall. But when we know there is a hole, then we will be protected.
- So what causes us to be delayed? When we fall into trials, so we break and need time to be taken out and recover. But what is better? To avoid all of these falls and slips, and that is when we believe in Allah Al 'Aleem The All-Knowing.
- when we enter something while being in a state where we do not know, but Allah (وتعائى) knows, then He will save us from desires that can make us slip and He will save us from doubts that can make us lose. So what protects us from thinking negatively? When we know that Allah (سبحانه وتعائى) knows and we do

not know. We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to increase us in knowledge. Ameen.

#### SURAH TA HA 114

### وَقُل رَّبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا

And say: "My Lord! Increase me in knowledge."

We can easily associate another partner with Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) when we attribute knowledge to ourselves.
