

Impact of lack of Tawakkul

- 1- Committing Shirk
- 2- people seek fulfillment of their needs and wishes by committing sins and evil deeds
- 3- Shedding blood, neglecting trusts, cheating, grudge, etc.
- 4- one sells his religion for the sake of Worldly gain
- 5- pleasing people and making Allah angry
- 6- Appearance of anxiety, fear, impatience, etc.






Surat ash Sharh (94: 5)
