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INTRODUCTION

SUPPLICATION FOR FORGIVENESS

فَاغْفِرْ لِي مَا قَدَّمْتُ وَمَا أَخَّرْتُ، وَمَا أَسْرَرْتُ وَمَا أَعْلَنْتُ، أَنْتَ
إِلَهِي، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ "

So please forgive my past and future sins and those sins which I did in secret or in public. It is You Whom I worship, None has the right to be worshipped except You ."¹

- ◉ We all want to go forward, no one wants to be delayed, and that is by being humble and seeking forgiveness from Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). On

the other hand, sins delay us. If we only look at ourselves then we will see ourselves as better and that is a cause of delay.

LIVE WITH THE QUR'AN – SURAH FUSSILAT TAFSIR AND TADDABUR

- Surah Fussilat is about calling to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and that is by tawheed Allah. We cannot see ourselves as doing something more, and at the same time, we should not underestimate calling to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- Previously we mentioned how the disbelievers rejected the truth, but the Book and Religion of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will not come down. It is bad for them, but it does not affect the Book and Religion of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). And the One Who

revealed the Book is The Most Wise, The Most Praiseworthy.

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مَا يُقَالُ لَكَ إِلَّا مَا قَدْ قِيلَ لِلرُّسُلِ مِنْ قَبْلِكَ ۚ إِنَّ رَبَّكَ لَذُو مَغْفِرَةٍ
وَذُو عِقَابٍ أَلِيمٍ

Nothing is said to you, [O Muhammad (ﷺ)],
except what was already said to the
messengers before you. Indeed, your Lord is a
possessor of forgiveness and a possessor of
painful penalty.

- In this ayah, we find console and support for the Prophet (ﷺ).
- (مَا يُقَالُ لَكَ إِلَّا مَا قَدْ قِيلَ لِلرُّسُلِ مِنْ قَبْلِكَ ۚ) (Nothing is said to you, [O Muhammad (ﷺ)], except what was already said to the messengers before you.): the Prophet (ﷺ) is the final and best messenger. Yet Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) tells him,

“anything that is said to you”, whether it is from the believers, disbelievers or a command from Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), has been said to the previous messengers. It is not something new.

- In all times, the disbelievers will argue with their messengers, deny them, dispraise them, mock them or accuse them.
- In the way to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), we will hear things we do not like, but we have to remember, it's been said to the messengers before.

SURAH AL BAQARAH 118

تَشَابَهَتْ قُلُوبُهُمْ ۚ

Their hearts resemble each other.

- Anything Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) has commanded the Prophet (ﷺ) is not something new because the

messengers have been commanded the same before.

SURAH AL AHQAAF 35

فَاصْبِرْ كَمَا صَبَرَ أُولُو الْعَزْمِ مِنَ الرُّسُلِ وَ

So be patient, [O Muhammad (ﷺ)], as were those of determination among the messengers

- ◉ When we know it is not something new, it gives console, and at the same time, it makes us to not see ourselves as something special.
- ◉ (إِنَّ رَبَّكَ) (Indeed, your Lord is): surely your Lord, Nurturer and Master is nurturing you. What should we know about our Lord?
- ◉ (لَذُوْ مَغْفِرَةٍ) (a possessor of forgiveness): He is The Owner of great forgiveness. And this means when we make any mistakes, we need to ask for forgiveness. And we will go forward with

forgiveness. When calling to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), it is important to call for forgiveness as well.

- ◉ (وَذُوْ عِقَابٍ أَلِيمٍ) (and a possessor of painful penalty.): Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the Owner of painful torment for the one who does not seek forgiveness, is stubborn and does not take the guidance. And this keeps us grounded and not transgress.
- ◉ This shows the caller to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) has both hope and fear of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

SURAH AZ ZUMAR 53

قُلْ يَا عِبَادِيَ الَّذِينَ أَسْرَفُوا عَلَىٰ أَنْفُسِهِمْ لَا تَقْنَطُوا مِن رَّحْمَةِ اللَّهِ إِنَّ اللَّهَ يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ جَمِيعًا إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ

Say: "O 'Ibadi (My slaves) who have transgressed against themselves (by committing evil deeds and sins)! Despair not of the Mercy of

Allah: verily, Allah forgives all sins. Truly He is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful.

BENEFITS FROM THE AYAH

- We should not think we are going through something no one has gone through because others before us have gone through the same.
- It is important to seek forgiveness and be humble.
