 Every decree is either good or bad and both are tests.

SURAH AL FURQAN 62

وَهُوَ الَّذِي جَعَلَ اللَّيْلَ وَالنَّهَارَ خِلْفَةً لِّلَنْ أَرَادَ أَن يَذَّكَّرَ أَوْ أَرَادَ شُكُورًا شُكُورًا

And it is He who has made the night and the day in succession for whoever desires to remember or desires gratitude.

o To have (أَزَادَ) is higher than to have a will. In good times and bad, the Ibaad ar Rahman have (أَزَادَ) to remember and to be grateful.

 In the times of darkness they remember good things and this helps them to be grateful in the times of light and goodness.

SURAH AL ISRAA' 18, 19 18.

Whoever should desire the immediate - We hasten for him from it what We will to whom We intend. Then We have made for him Hell, which he will [enter to] burn, censured and banished.

19.

But whoever desires the Hereafter and exerts the effort due to it while he is a believer - it is those whose effort is ever appreciated [by Allah].

- We want to have iraada for good and not for bad.
- The ibaad Ar Rahman had iraada in the day and in the night.
- We cannot remember or be grateful without the foundation of patience.
- Patience is way out from calamity and Allah rewards the patient without account.

LIVE WITH THE QUR'AN-SURAH AAL IMRAAN

- What shows who believes and who does not and who submits and who does not? The ayat of Allah in His decrees and legislations.
- A person may not have a problem specifically with the legislation but with the one who is conveying it.

LISTEN AND OBEY

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ . رضى الله عنه . قَالَ قَالَ رَسُولُ اللّهِ صلى الله عليه وسلم " اسْمَعُوا وَأَطِيعُوا وَإِنِ اسْتُعْمِلَ عَلَيْكُمْ عَبْدٌ الله عليه وسلم " اسْمَعُوا وَأَطِيعُوا وَإِنِ اسْتُعْمِلَ عَلَيْكُمْ عَبْدٌ الله عليه وسلم " حَبَشِيُّ كَأَنَّ رَأْسَهُ زَبِيبَةٌ ".

Narrated Anas bin Malik: Allah's Messenger () said, "You should listen to and obey, your ruler even if he was an Ethiopian (black) slave whose head looks like a raisin."

- We obey whoever Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) gave a position above us except if they command anything against what Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) said.
- o The first crime in history is killing. One of the sons of Adam (عليه السلام) killed the other and this was out of jealousy. Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) accepted sacrifice from the one who gave the best and did not accept from the one who dd not give the best.
- When we hear this we do not ascribe purity
 to ourselves and think 'I will never do this'.
 We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) for well-being from
 falling into these major sins.
- Killing is even mentioned in the passage about Ibaad Ar Rahman.

SURAH AL FURQAN 68

وَالَّذِينَ لَا يَدْعُونَ مَعَ اللَّهِ إِلَٰهًا آخَرَ وَلَا يَقْتُلُونَ النَّفْسَ الَّتِي حَرَّمَ اللَّهُ إِلَّا بِالْحَقِّ وَلَا يَزْنُونَ ۚ وَمَن يَفْعَلْ ذَٰلِكَ يَلْقَ أَثَامًا And those who do not invoke with Allah another deity or kill the soul which Allah has forbidden [to be killed], except by right, and do not commit unlawful sexual intercourse. And whoever should do that will meet a penalty.

- Khidr wanted to teach Musa (عليه السلام) to submit in the decree of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
 He told Musa (عليه السلام) to not speak even when he killed a boy yet he spoke. These situations are not easy.
- We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to help us submit
 in His decrees and never attribute goodness
 and perfection to ourselves.

SEVEN GREAT DESTRUCTIVE SINS

Narrated Abu Huraira (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ه) said, "Avoid the seven great destructive sins." They (the people!) asked, "O Allah's Messenger! What are they?" He said, "To join partners in worship with Allah; to practice sorcery; to kill the life which Allah has forbidden except for a just cause (according to Islamic law); to eat up usury (Riba), to eat up the property of an orphan; to give one's back to the enemy and fleeing from the battle-field at the time of fighting and to accuse chaste women who never even think of anything touching chastity and are good believers."²

 Killing is from the seven great destructive sins.
