INTRODUCTION

SURAH AL FATIHA 2

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ

[All] praise is [due] to Allah, Lord of the worlds -

- Allah Al Haseeb deals with us with no account, and how many times has He saved us and guided us with no account?
- All praises are due to Allah – Lord of the Worlds. We praise Him for His nurturing of all the worlds.

He nurtures us, the people around us, the weather, the angels and even the devils.

- In the final ayah of Surah Az Zumar, when everyone is in their eternal abode. When the people of paradise are there forever and when the people of the hellfire are there forever then all of them will say “alhamdulillah Rabb al ‘Alameen.” All of them praise Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) for His nurturing.
- If we do not know Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) then we will not say “Alhamdulillah Rabb Al ‘Alameen.”
- Knowing Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) gives us life, knowing Him reforms us from our roots, from our heart, from our actions and from our speech.
- We are here in this life to know Who is Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). Imagine someone rich sets up a business and he brings people to work there

and he says, "I do not need anything from you except keep connecting with me." And then these workers just think of themselves and their problems, they fight with each other and forget to keep the connection.

- And to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) is the best example, He brought us into existence, He created us, He provides us and guides us, but we forget Him and forget to connect to Him, subhan Allah.
- This life has no taste if we do not know Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and believe in Him. And we ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to always make us taste the sweetness of faith.
- The messengers went through great tests, but they never saw these tests as pain, but saw it as the love of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). Allah (سبحانه وتعالى)

loves them and they love Him, so the feeling of love overpowers the pain.

- The best dua is “alhamdulilah” because when we praise Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) we are actually seeking His nearness and pleasure.
