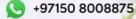


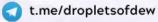

#### INTRODUCTION

#### SURAH AT TALAQ 3

#### وَمَن يَتَوَكَّلْ عَلَى اللَّهِ فَهُوَ حَسْبُهُ ،

And whoever relies upon Allah - then He is sufficient for him.

We are here in this life to be a slave of Allah (سبحانه وتعالی), and a slave of Allah (سبحانه وتعالی) is one who loves. Our nafs finds comfort with itself, but trust comfort is with Allah (سبحانه وتعالی).

- Someone with knowledge will be nurtured with things they do not know, just as in the story of Musa (عليه السلام) and Al Khidr. This type of nurturing is so that a person does not depend on their knowledge and experience, but accept the decrees that come because Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will teach us something new.
- We always want to make dua to Allah (وتعالى) for whatever we go through, and imagine how many duas we can make in a day. We always want to be connected to Allah (وتعالى).
- When a person first accepts Islam, their heart is flying and feelings so much sweetness. But then with time a person starts to go into routine and loses the feelings. But it is important to have

- trust in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to keep the feelings and not depend on ourselves.
- The nafs does not like it when changes start to happen around it. When we want to do something, we can have so many things running in our mind and taking into account everything, but when we place our trust in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), He will be Sufficient for us. He will take things into account so we do not need to worry.
- Sometimes, we can take the sensitivities of our nafs very seriously, but forget to have feelings of love for Allah (سبحانه وتعالى), His Messenger (ﷺ) and others for His sake.

- with tawakul there are no accounts. There is no thinking, "is it a good time now, will it be fine if I say this, maybe this can happen if we go" and so forth. With tawakul it is that leap of faith in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and to have the courage to take that step.
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) places us in situations in order to strengthen our faith and remove any cowardice we may have.

- Banu Israel was commanded by Allah (وتعالى) to enter the land, though they refused since there were people already there. But now it is not about formalities if someone is already there because it is a command from Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- We just have to take a step forward and that is the struggle against our nafs and our calculations.
- They had to enter a town that had tyrants, and because they already went through a time with a previous tyrant with Firaoun they do not want to go through it again. They already experienced what it is like to be with a tyrant, so they do not want to fall into it again. And then along the way, the nafs will remind us of hadiths and ayat so that we do not do it. But

Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) nurtures so that He frees us from the knots in our life.

They were afraid of what will happen to them due to their past, but they ended up getting lost for forty years. Just as they get lost with their thinking, they ended up getting lost from finding their home. And similarly for us, when opportunities come, when doors open, we do not want to get stuck with our past experience. Each time Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will teach us something different, but it is important to not attach to our experience, but to be foremost and place our trust in Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).

MAY ALLAH MAKE US AMONG THE FOREMOST WHO ALWAYS PLACE THEIR TRUST IN HIM. AMEEN.
