### INTRODUCTION

- We love the Prophet (ﷺ) more than we love ourselves. And we will not attain faith until we love for our brother what we love for ourselves.
- We love ourselves, but birr is to love Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and love the Prophet Mohammed (ﷺ) more than ourselves.

## LIVE WITH THE PROPHET (ﷺ)

### THE PROPHET (ﷺ) IS A SHEPHERD AT THE AGE OF 8

- Previously we mentioned that the Prophet (ﷺ) went to live in the home of his uncle Abu Talib after the death of his grandfather.
- Abu Talib had many children, so he to delegate tasks, and the Prophet (ﷺ) was assigned to shepherd sheep at the age of eight.
- The Prophet (ﷺ) mentioned that all the messengers were shepherds and this is great nurturing to lead people in the future. We think someone who will lead people must be pampered and go to the best universities. But to be a shepherd requires all senses to be open. The shepherd has to think ahead for the sheep and what they might do.

## QUALITIES ATTAINED FROM SHEPHERDING SHEEP

- **Patience:** sheep are extremely slow in eating, so a person has to be patient. The shepherd has to wait for the sheep, gather them and chase after them. And this patience is needed in the future when dealing with different types of people and natures.
- **Humble:** a shepherd cannot keep his clothes clean because there can be all kinds of discharge. And in the future, the disbelievers of Quraish placed the intestines of the camel on the neck of the Prophet (ﷺ) while prostrating. And a shepherd has to be around sheep and sleep near them, so this makes a person humble.

- **Bravery:** the shepherd needs to take care of the sheep from being attacked by wolves or from coming too near to the edge.
- So all of this was preparation to becoming a messenger. A person needs to be patient, does not show-off and is not afraid to say the truth and be on the side of the truth.
- And these qualities were not taught by his parents, but through situations.
- Patience, humbleness and bravery are all qualities found in the messengers.
