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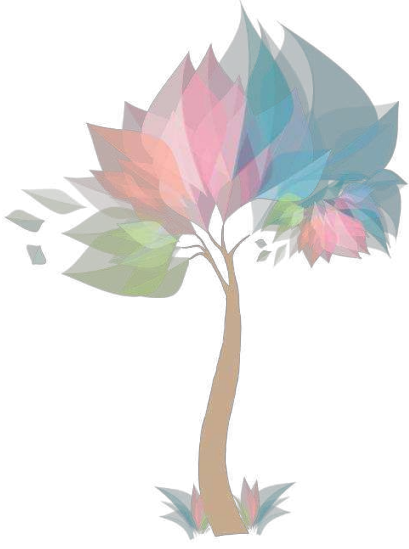

Teacher Guidelines

Our goal is Allah's pleasure and His paradise.

(اللهم أعنا على ذكرك وشكرك وحسن عبادتك)

O Allah help us to remember You, be grateful to You and worship You in excellence (with ihsaan).

Hadith: وعن ابن عمر رضي الله عنهما عن النبي صلى الله عليه وسلم قال: " كلكم راعٍ، وكلكم مسئول عن رعيته، فالرجل راعٍ على أهل بيته؛ والمرأة راعية على بيت زوجها وولده، فكلكم راعٍ، وكلكم مسئول عن رعيته"

(Ibn 'Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) reported: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "All of you are guardians and are responsible for your subjects. The ruler is a guardian of his subjects, the man is a guardian of his family, the woman is a guardian and is responsible for her husband's house and his offspring; and so all of you are guardians and are responsible for your subjects.")

– Riyadh As Saliheen, Al Bukhari & Muslim, Book 1, Hadith 283

Allah has opened a great door of worship to teach children. As a teacher we are accountable for what we teach the children and our goal is to teach what is pleasing to Allah which is according to the Qur'an and the Sunnah.

Teaching about Allah, His religion and the unseen are a great amanah. It is important to teach the children to both love and magnify Allah, and to magnify the pillars of faith such as the angels, books, messengers, Last Day and decree.

When using teaching resources and methods, it is important to maintain the magnification of Allah and His Words, The Qur'an.

Matters to Consider before Teaching

- Renew the intention and make the heart present that it's being done for Allah.

- Hope for the reward from Allah.

Hadith: (مَنْ دَعَا إِلَى هُدًى كَانَ لَهُ)
(مِنْ الْأَجْرِ مِثْلُ أُجُورِ مَنْ تَبِعَهُ لَا يَنْقُصُ ذَلِكَ مِنْ أُجُورِهِمْ شَيْئًا)

(Abu Huraira reported Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) as saying: He who called (people) to righteousness, there would be reward (assured) for him like the rewards of those who adhered to it, without their rewards being diminished in any respect. - *Sahih Muslim 2674*)

- Ask Allah for the tawfeeq and success in what you're doing.

وَمَا تَوْفِيقِي إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَإِلَيْهِ أُنِيبُ

And my guidance cannot come except from Allah, in Him I trust and unto Him I repent (Surah Hud 88)

- Adorn yourself with praiseworthy morals such as being fair with the students, humble, patient, gentle, do not get angry, and be tranquil.
- Plant important concepts such as honesty, truthfulness, being fair, good morals, sharing, and moderation in everything.

- Make your voice clear, do not scream at the children, and adorn your words with praise at times, or make dua for them, smile and reward them when good.
- Prepare the student to receive the knowledge by ensuring all are quiet.

Matters to Consider while Teaching

- Names of Allah are to be enforced through situations they go through by reminding them to ask Allah. For example, if a child says, 'I'm hungry'. Tell them, 'ask Allah first to give you food'.
- Encourage children to say (ﷺ) after the Prophet's name is mentioned.
- Encourage children to say 'assalam alaykum' (السلام عليكم) and 'jazaka Allah khair' (جزاك الله خيرا) to each other.
- Encourage children to not speak when the Qur'an is recited but to listen carefully.
- Avoid explaining attributes or actions of Allah with gestures. For example, Allah has Hands and Eyes, do not show your hands or point to your eyes as a way of explanation. It is important to tell the children 'Allah has Hands but it is not like ours, we cannot imagine how'. We cannot imagine how Allah looks, Exalted is He. It's important to push away these thoughts and say (أعوذ بالله من الشيطان الرجيم) and (أستغفر الله). These thoughts are from the shaitan.
- Avoid using the names of Allah or the ayat of the Qur'an or the angels or prophets as a coloring activity since this shows lack of magnification.
- Avoid books or showing cartoons which show images of the prophets, angels or the Last Day. This will disturb their belief in the unseen when

they see it as an image. As a teacher, you can tell them about these matters verbally.

- When a child listens then reward them by saying 'good job, well done, or sticker'. When a child doesn't listen then encourage them to listen and not put them down. Do not use Allah's name or the Prophet's to make the children do or not so something, such as 'Allah will love you when you eat your food', 'Allah does not like those who don't listen'. The name of Allah is to be magnified and not used to make the children listen to you.

May Allah guide us to what He loves and is pleased with. Ameen.

(من الذي خلقك؟ الله الخالق)
- Who made the sky and the land? (الله الخالق)
- Who made the night and day? (الله الخالق)
- Who made the sun and moon? (الله الخالق)
- Who made the mountains and seas? (الله الخالق)
- Who made the animals and birds? (الله الخالق)
- Who made the fruits and vegetables? (الله الخالق)
- Who made everything? (الله الخالق)

SAY THE AYAH: (الله خَالِقُ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ)

Action (عمل)

- Allah made us in order to do what He tells us.
- Know how great is Allah because He made everything.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الرَّبِّ

Ar Rabb - The Nurturer

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah Ar Rabb is The Nurturer, The Reformer, The Grantor of blessings
- Who is taking care of you? (الله الرب)
- Who is taking care of our parents? (الله الرب)
- Who is taking care of the animals? (الله الرب)
- Who is giving you food and water? (الله الرب)
- Who is giving you air to breathe? (الله الرب)
- Who is teaching you? (الله الرب)
- Who is making you grow? (الله الرب)
- Who is showing you right and wrong? (الله الرب)

SAY THE AYAH: (الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ)

Action (عمل)

- When you want something, ask (الله الرَّبِّ).
- Say 'Ya Rabb' take me to Jannah.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

السميع

As Samie' - The All-Hearer

Knowledge (علم)

- (الله السميع) is the One Who has all hearing.
- Who hears everything? (الله السميع)
- Who hears you when you speak? (الله السميع)
- Who hears you when you're quiet? (الله السميع)
- Who hears you even when you ask for help?
(الله السميع)
- Who hears the ant? (الله السميع)
- Who hears you when you say something good?
(الله السميع)
- Who hears your when you say something bad?
(الله السميع)
- Who hears everyone at the same time?
(الله السميع)
- Who answers you when you make dua?
(الله السميع)

SAY THE AYAH: (إِنَّ رَبِّي لَسَمِيعُ الدُّعَاءِ)

Action (عمل)

- Say good words, do not say bad words.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

البصير

Al Baseer - The All-Seeing

Knowledge (علم)

- (الله البصير) Is the One Who has all seeing.
- Who sees everything? (الله البصير)
- Who sees you when you wake-up? (الله البصير)
- Who sees you when you're at school? (الله البصير)
- Who sees you when you're at home? (الله البصير)
- Who sees you when you sleep? (الله البصير)
- Who can see everything even if it's dark?
(الله البصير)
- Who sees us when we do good things?
(الله البصير)
- Who sees us when we do something bad?
(الله البصير)

- If mommy and daddy are not there, Who sees us?

(الله البصير)

SAY THE AYAH: (وَاللَّهُ بَصِيرٌ بِالْعِبَادِ)

Action (عمل)

- Do good things, not do bad things because Allah sees us.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الرزاق

Ar Razaaq - The Provider

Knowledge (علم)

- (الله الرزاق) is in charge of everyone's rizq.
- Who gives you everything?
(من الذي رزقك؟ الله الرزاق)
- Who brings down the rain? (الله الرزاق)
- Who gives food to all the people and the animals?
(الله الرزاق)
- Who gave you eyes, ears, and a heart? (الله الرزاق)
- Who do you ask if you want a toy? (الله الرزاق)
- Who do you ask if you want ice cream? (الله الرزاق)
- Who do you ask if you to go swimming? (الله الرزاق)
- If you want something, who do you ask? (الله الرزاق)

Action (عمل)

- Allah gave us everything, what do we do? Say “**Alhamdulillah**” and listen to Allah.
- Ask Allah **Ar Razaq** to give you.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الصمد

As Samad - The All-Solid

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah As Samad is The One everyone goes to for their needs.
- Everyone eats but Who doesn't eat? Allah As Samad
- Everyone drinks but Who doesn't drink? Allah As Samad
- Everyone is born to someone but Who's not born to anyone? Allah As Samad
- Everyone has a mother and father but Who doesn't have a mother or father? Allah As Samad
- Who doesn't have a son or daughter? Allah As Samad
- Everyone gets hurt but Who doesn't get hurt? Allah As Samad
- Who's the One Whom everyone can go to for whatever they want? Allah As Samad

Action (عمل)

- We do everything for Allah
- Whoever recites Surah Al Ikhlas ten times, Allah will build a palace for him in paradise.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

المؤمن

Al Mu'min - The Grantor of Security

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Mu'min** The One Who verifies His Oneness.
- Who gave us a roof over our heads so things don't fall on our heads? **Allah Al Mu'min**
- Who gave us a fridge to protect our food? **Allah Al Mu'min**
- Who gave us an umbrella to protect us from the rain? **Allah Al Mu'min**
- Who protects us from big and scary animals? **Allah Al Mu'min**
- Who gave us a jacket to protect us from the cold? **Allah Al Mu'min**

- Who gave us sunglasses to protect our eyes from the sun? Allah Al Mu'min
- If we're scared of something, Who will remove the fear? Allah Al Mu'min

Action (عمل)

- We ask Allah Al Mu'min to not make us scared
- We should not scare others

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الطيب

At Tayyib - The Most Pure

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah At Tayyib** is purified from all faults.
- Who loves the good word? **Allah At Tayyib**
- Who accepts the good actions? **Allah At Tayyib**
- Who gave us good food? **Allah At Tayyib**
- Who gave us honey, fruits and vegetables? **Allah At Tayyib**
- Who brings down pure rain water from the sky? **Allah At Tayyib**
- Who created us pure? **Allah At Tayyib**

Action (عمل)

- We eat good and healthy food and do good
- Say good words to each other
- The good word is (لا اله الا الله)

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الملك

Al Malik - The King

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah Al Malik is the Only One Who in charge of everything.
- Who owns the heavens and the earth? Allah Al Malik
- Who owns the lion, tiger and elephant? Allah Al Malik
- Who owns the ant, bee and spider? Allah Al Malik
- Who owns the people, your mother, father, brothers and sisters? Allah Al Malik
- Who owns all homes, castles and buildings? Allah Al Malik
- If you want anything, whom should you ask? Allah Al Malik

Action (عمل)

- Be humble because Allah is the King
- Ask Allah Al Malik when we want anything

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

اللطيف

Al Lateef - The Most Subtle, Gentle

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Lateef** Whose gentleness in creation and wisdom disables the minds.
- Who makes you grow little by little? **Allah Al Lateef**
- Who makes the plants grow little by little? **Allah Al Lateef**
- Who makes the animals grow little by little? **Allah Al Lateef**
- Who teaches you little by little? **Allah Al Lateef**
- Who brings food to you that's made up of ingredients coming from different places? **Allah Al Lateef, He's so Kind and Gentle**

Action (عمل)

- Be patient with others and do everything in a steady pace
- Ask Allah Al Lateef to have lutf on you.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الستير

Al Sitteer - The Concealer

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Sitteer** The One Who covers much.
- Who gave us skin to cover our bodies? **Allah Al Sitteer**
- Who gave us clothes to cover our bodies? **Allah Al Sitteer**
- Who told us to cover our 'awras? **Allah Al Sitteer**
- Who told the woman to cover her hair with the hijab? **Allah Al Sitteer**
- Who told us not to talk about people's mistakes? **Allah Al Sitteer**

Action (عمل)

- Not make fun of others when they make a mistake. For example, if someone tries to jump and they

fall then we shouldn't make fun of them or tell others about it.

- To cover our 'awras. Make dua (اللهم استر عوراتي)
O Allah cover our awras.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

القوي

Al Qawiy - The Most Strong

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Qawiy** Whom all power belongs to Him.
- Who is the strongest? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who made the mountains so strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who made the train so strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who made the tree so strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who made the lion so strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who made the tiger so strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- Who can make you strong? **Allah Al Qawiy**
- When you're tired, who can make you strong?
Allah Al Qawiy
- When you are sick, who can make you strong?
Allah Al Qawiy
- Who doesn't need help? **Allah Al Qawiy**

Action (عمل)

- Ask Allah to make us strong (لا حول ولا قوة الا بالله)
'There is no change or strength except with Allah'.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الكريم

Al Kareem - The Most Generous

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Kareem** Whom no one is more generous than Him.
- Who gave us more than one type of clothing?
Allah Al Kareem
- Who gave us more than one type of fruit?
Allah Al Kareem
- Who gave us more than one type of vegetable?
Allah Al Kareem
- Who gave us more than one type of apple?
Allah Al Kareem
- Who gave us more than one type of transport?
Allah Al Kareem
- Who taught us to read, write and speak?
Allah Al Kareem

Action (عمل)

- We should be generous to others, especially our family, neighbors and guests.
- We should share with others and not be stingy.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

العظيم

Al 'Adheem - The Greatest

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al 'Adheem** Whom all greatness belongs to Him.
- Who is the One Who can fit the entire sky and earth in His Hand? **Allah Al 'Adheem**
- Who is the One Whose Kursi is so great, greater than the sky and earth? **Allah Al 'Adheem**
- Who is the One above the seven skies and so big? **Allah Al 'Adheem**
- Who is the One Who is never tired, never scared and can solve all problems? **Allah Al 'Adheem**
- Who is the One which nothing can be stronger, bigger or higher than Him? **Allah Al 'Adheem**

Action (عمل)

- We should do what Allah tells us and stay away from the things He told us to stay away from.
- We should respect Allah and all the places, times and things which He made special such as Makkah, Dhul Hijjah, adhaan, and hijab.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الودود

Al Wadood - The Most Loving

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Wadood** Is the Most Beloved and He deserves all of our love.
- Who is the One Who loves us more than our mother, father and friends? **Allah Al Wadood**
- Who is the One puts the love between our mother and father and our brothers and sisters? **Allah Al Wadood**
- Who shows us love by making us Muslims, teaching us Qur'an and letting us to learn about Him? **Allah Al Wadood**
- If we make a mistake and we're sorry for it, Who will still love us? **Allah Al Wadood**
- If we feel we're not being loved, Who should we ask for love? **Allah Al Wadood**

Action (عمل)

- Ask Allah Al Wadood to love you
- Be loving to your parents, family, teachers, friends and animals
- Love each other for the sake of Allah

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

القَابِضُ البَاسِطُ

Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit

The Withholder, The Expander

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit** Is the One Who holds and gives according to His perfect power and wisdom.
- Who is the One Who can give us many things and Who is the One Who can hold back from us many things? **Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit**
- Who is the One Who gives life and Who is the One Who holds back life? **Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit**
- Who is the One Who causes the rain to fall and Who is the One Who stops the rain from all falling? **Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit**
- Who is the One Who stretches the shadow and Who is the One Who pulls back the shadow so we have day and night? **Allah Al Qabidh Al Basit**

Action (عمل)

- When Allah gives us things, we should be grateful.
- When Allah holds back things from us, we should still be grateful because Allah knows it's not good for us to have it right now.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

المصور

Allah Al Mussawir

The Fashioner of Forms

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah Al Mussawir The Only One Who can fashion forms.
- Who is the One Who gave us of a special nose, special mouth and special eyes? Allah Al Mussawir
- Who is the One Who gave wings to the birds, tails to the animals, and hands to the humans? Allah Al Mussawir
- Who is the One Who gave every person and every animal a different look and shape, but made each one look the best way? Allah Al Mussawir
- Who is the One Who can make our life look beautiful? Allah Al Mussawir

Action (عمل)

- Do not make fun of how a person or an animal looks because Allah is the One Who made them look like that.
- If something is not nice in your life, ask Allah Al Mussawir to make it beautiful.
- Look at the beauty in everything because Allah Al Mussawir gave it that look.
- Everyone is special, no two people are the same.
- Do not draw pictures of humans or animals because only Allah can give them the perfect look.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الواسع

Al Wasi' - The Most Vast

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Wasi'** The One Who is Vast in His names and actions.
- Who is the One Who made the sky and sea so big that we can't even see where it begins and ends? **Allah Al Wasi'**
- Who is the One Who can give you more than you can imagine? **Allah Al Wasi'**
- Who is the One Who can make your room and home bigger? **Allah Al Wasi'**
- Who is the One Who can make space for you when a place is crowded? **Allah Al Wasi'**

Action (عمل)

- Always think big and hope for the best from Allah. Ask Allah for the best place in Jenna which is Firdaous Al 'Ala. Ask Allah to enter with no hisab.
- Ask Allah to have a good life now and a good life in the akhira.
- Look up at the sky and see how far it goes. Look at the sea and see how far it stretches. And I know Allah is Al Wasi'.
- If you can't find space, ask Allah Al Wasi' to make space for you

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الشافعي

Ash Shafee - The Curer

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Shafee** cures the souls and bodies from sickness.
- Who is the One Who will remove your cough, fever and pain? **Allah Al Shafee**
- Who is the One Who will heal your leg, arms or fingers if you break them? **Allah Al Shafee**
- Who is the One Who will make you feel better if you fall and get hurt? **Allah Al Shafee**
- If we see someone who is sick, Who do we ask to make them get better? **Allah Al Shafee**
- If we feel jealous, Who should we ask to make our heart better? **Allah Al Shafee**

Action (عمل)

- When we fall sick, we ask Allah Al Shafee to cure us.
- When we're sick, recite Surah Al Fatiha seven times because Surah Al Fatiha is Al Shafiya.
- When you feel pain, ask Allah Al Shafee to make you better before you ask anyone else and before you take medicine.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

البر

Al Barr

The Most Kind and Generous

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Barr** Is the most generous and kind to His slaves.
- Who is the One Who makes us do good things?
Allah Al Barr
- Who is the One Who makes us help others?
Allah Al Barr
- Who is the One Who makes us be good to our parents? **Allah Al Barr**
- Who is the One Who counts every good we do at least ten times to 700 times? **Allah Al Barr**
- Who is the One Who counts every bad we do as one time? **Allah Al Barr**

Action (عمل)

- Be good to your parents by speaking nicely to them, not screaming at them, listening to them and doing what they say.
- Ask Allah Al Barr to open for you to do good things such as giving food to the poor, watering the plants, giving leftover bread to the birds.
- For every letter of the Qur'an we say, we get ten good deeds

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الحكيم

Al Hakeem - The All-Wise

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Hakeem** The One Who has the greatest wisdom in creation and commands.
- Who is the One Who knows why we are short or tall? **Allah Al Hakeem**
- Who is the One Who knows why we are healthy or sick? **Allah Al Hakeem**
- Who is the One Who knows why we are rich or poor? **Allah Al Hakeem**
- Who is the One Who knows why things happen while we can't understand? **Allah Al Hakeem**
- Who is the One Who puts everything in its right place? **Allah Al Hakeem**
- Who is the One Who never does anything wrong? **Allah Al Hakeem**

Action (عمل)

- Ask Allah to make you understand His actions.
- Always think good of Allah, even if something looks bad because there is good in it. For example, we might have a cough and can't go to a party. But Allah knows if we went to the party then we might have gotten hurt and broken our leg. So out of Allah's wisdom we get sick in order to be protected from something worse. There is always good in everything.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

الحي

Al Hayy - The Ever-Living

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Hayy** is the Ever-Living Who never dies
(الله الحي الذي لا يموت)
- Who gives life to angels, humans, animals and plants? **Allah Al Hayy**
- Who does not sleep? **Allah Al Hayy**
- Who does not get tired? **Allah Al Hayy**
- Who does not forget? **Allah Al Hayy**
- Who does not die? **Allah Al Hayy**
- Who can make us live a good life? **Allah Al Hayy**

Action (عمل)

- Believe and do good because Allah will give us a good life.
- Help to save other people's and animal's lives by giving clean water.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

المقيت

Al Muqheet-The Nourisher

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Muqheet** is the One in charge of bringing nourishment to all creation

(المتكفل بإيصال قوته إلى كل مخلوق)

- Who brings to us all the food we need?

Allah Al Muqheet

- Who is the One Who gives milk to the baby and food to the child? **Allah Al Muqheet**

- Who is the One Who knows what each person needs at every stage of his life? **Allah Al Muqheet**

Action (عمل)

- I ask **Allah Al Muqet** to give me food that is best for me.
- I eat healthy food.
- I give the creation food suitable for them. For example, I give a bird some seeds and do not give it chocolate.
- When feeling hot, I drink something cool like juice.
- When feeling cold, I drink something warm like soup.

The Grateful, The Most Appreciative

Knowledge (علم)

- Who is the One Who counts every good deed we do from 10 to 700 times, to even more?

Allah Ash Shakir Ash Shakoor

- Who is the One Who appreciates what we do, even if it is not perfect? Allah Ash Shakir Ash Shakoor

- Who is the One Who appreciates what we do for others, even if people do not appreciate it?

Allah Ash Shakir Ash Shakoor

- Who is the One Who appreciates it when we are grateful, so He gives us more?

Allah Ash Shakir Ash Shakoor

Action (عمل)

- Anything you do, do it for Allah and not the people. Allah always appreciates what we do but the people cannot always do that.
- Be grateful for all that Allah has given you. Be grateful to your parents, to your teachers, to your siblings and friends.
- When someone does something for you- tell them “jazak Allah khair”.
- Appreciate what others do for you, even if you do not like it or want it, why? Because they tried to do something for you.
- When you are grateful to Allah, He will give you more good things. This can be learning more, better manners, understanding more, or being helpful to the people.

- Who is the One we can ask to give us anything we want, no matter how expensive it is?
Allah Al Ghaniy
- Who can make us happy and rich? Allah Al Ghaniy

Action (عمل)

- When you need something, like a backpack, clothes, food or toy, ask Allah Al Ghaniy to give you.
- When you want a toy and your mommy says “we can’t get it”, ask Allah Al Ghaniy to give you.
- Do not beg or be needy to the people, beg and ask Allah Al Ghaniy.
- Help those in need by giving them food, water, warm clothes, or even money.

Note to Teacher: When dealing with children, remind them to take everything back to Allah first before the means.

Al Khabeer - The All-Aware

Knowledge (علم)

- **Allah Al Khabeer** is the One Whose knowledge covers everything that's hidden
(الله الخبير الذي أحاط علمه ببواطن الأشياء).
- Who is the One Who knows when we eat something, if it will make us healthier or will cause us to be sick? **Allah Al Khabeer**
- Who is the One Who knows when we buy a toy, if we will get hurt by it or not? **Allah Al Khabeer**
- Who is the One Who knows what we are thinking and feeling inside ourselves even if we do not say it? **Allah Al Khabeer**
- Who is the One Who knows all our secrets? **Allah Al Khabeer**
- Who is the One Who knows exactly how everything is made from beginning to end? **Allah Al Khabeer**

- Who is the One Who can make us expert in anything? **Allah Al Khabeer**

Action (عمل)

- We should not lie to our parents because **Allah Al Khabeer** knows our secrets.
- When we start anything, we should ask **Allah Al Khabeer** to bring what's good for us and keep away what's bad for us.
- When there is something we cannot understand, we ask **Allah Al Khabeer** to make us understand.
- When we want to learn and be good at something for example to be a very good teacher or to be a very good engineer, we ask **Allah Al Khabeer**.

- Who is the One Who can make us reach Firdous Al 'Ala? Allah Al 'Ala

Action (عمل)

- If we see something tall and high, like a tall building or mountain or skies, we should remember Allah is Al 'Ala and He is Higher.
- If we think someone is so high and great, we need to know Allah is Higher, He is Al 'Ala.
- We should not think we are better than everyone else because Allah is Higher, He is Al 'Ala.

Al Muhsin - The Doer of Excellence

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah Al Muhsin the One Who perfected all that He created.

(الله المحسن الذي أحسن كل شيء خلقه)

- Who is the One Who made us perfect by creating us with two eyes and not one eye? Allah Al Muhsin
- Who is the One Who made us perfect by creating us with two ears and not one ear? Allah Al Muhsin
- Who is the One Who gave us the best deen to follow? Allah Al Muhsin
- Who is the One always doing good to us by creating us, giving us food, clothes, water, and a home? Allah Al Muhsin
- Who tells us we can do anything in the best way? Allah Al Muhsin

Action (عمل)

- Imagine if all humans had only one eye or one ear. How would that look? Be grateful to **Allah Al Muhsin** for making us in the best form.
- If you are speaking to your parents, speak to them with ihsan which means be kind and gentle to them; do not scream at them.
- If you are doing your homework, do it with ihsan which means do it well and nicely.
- You can do anything with ihsan like tidying up your room, brushing your hair, and talking politely to others.

Al 'Aleem - The Most Knowledgeable

Knowledge (علم)

- Allah is Al 'Aleem and there is no one more knowledgeable than Him

(الله العليم الذي لا أعلم منه)

- Who knows whenever any leaf falls?
Allah Al 'Aleem
- Who knows how many fish are in the ocean?
Allah Al 'Aleem
- Who knows what I need before my tongue speaks?
Allah Al 'Aleem
- Who knows all our secrets? Allah Al 'Aleem
- Who taught Adam (Peace be upon him) the names of everything? Allah Al 'Aleem

Action (عمل)

- Ask **Allah Al 'Aleem** to increase you in knowledge.

رَبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا

O my Lord increase me in knowledge

- Only Allah has knowledge of our past, present and future. He knows what is good for us now and what is better for us in the future. We need to trust Allah and believe that everything He does for us is good.
- **Allah Al 'Aleem** knows how we feel. He knows about us when we feel sad or scared or nervous. That is why we should remember Him and ask Him before we go to anyone else for help.

- Allah is One, but people can be two or more, plants can be two or more, animals can be two or more, objects can be two or more.

Pillars of Faith

I. Belief in Allah

ذَٰلِكُمْ اللَّهُ رَبُّكُمْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ خَلَقَ كُلَّ شَيْءٍ
فَاعْبُدُوهُ وَهُوَ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ وَكِيلٌ ﴿١٠٢﴾

That is Allah, your Lord; there is no deity except Him, the Creator of all things, so worship Him. And He is Disposer of all things. (Al-'An'am: 102)

Tawheed Ar Roboobiyyah

- Only Allah is Ar Rabb.
- Allah takes care of us.
- Allah gives us everything we need.
- Only Allah is the Creator.
- Only Allah controls everything in the sky and on the earth.
- Only Allah gives life and death.
- Everything in the universe belongs Only to Allah.
- Allah takes care of all His creations.

Tawheed Al Oloohiyyah

- We pray Only to Allah.
- We make dua' Only to Allah.

- We do all our good deeds Only for Allah

Tawheed Al Asma wa As-Sifaat

- All of Allah's names are Beautiful.
- Allah informed us about His Names.
- We don't change the meaning of Allah's Names.
- We make dua to Allah by His Names, for example, "Ya Raheem, Ya Ghafoor, Ya Razzak.."
- All of Allah's attributes are Perfect.
- We don't compare Allah to His Creations.
- No one can have qualities like Allah.

Ash-Shirk

قُلْ إِنَّمَا أَدْعُوا رَبِّي وَلَا أُشْرِكُ بِهِ أَحَدًا ۝۲۰

Say (O Muhammad ﷺ): "I invoke only my Lord (Allah Alone), and I associate none as partners along with Him." (Al Jinn:20)

- Allah told us not to do Shirk.
- Shirk is to worship something or someone other than Allah.
- Shirk is to believe something or someone other than Allah can create.
- Shirk is to believe something or someone other than Allah has control of everything.
- Shirk is to believe something or someone other than Allah can give life or death.
- Shirk is to make dua to someone else other than Allah.
- Shirk is to do our good deeds for someone else other than Allah.

لا اله الا الله

2. Belief in the Angels

- We cannot see the angels.
- Angels are made of light.
- Angels do not eat or drink or sleep.
- Angels do everything Allah tells them.
- Angels love those who believe in Allah.
- Angels have wings. Some have two wings, some have three wings, some have four wings.
- Jibreel is the head of all angels and he has 600 wings.
- Each of us has two angels, one writes all the good we say and do, and one writes all the bad we say and do.

3. Belief in the Books

- Allah sent down a Book with every Messenger.
 - Tawrat was sent to Musa (عليه السلام)
 - Injeel was sent to Eisa (عليه السلام)
 - Zaboor was sent to Dawood (عليه السلام)
 - Suhuh was sent to Ibrahim (عليه السلام)
- Allah sent down books to guide people to Allah and His religion.
- We believe in all the books that Allah sent down but we follow only the Qur'an which Allah sent down on the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.
- The Qur'an is the Word of Allah which Allah spoke to Jibreel and Jibreel brought it to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

4. Belief in the Messengers

- We believe that the messengers were the best of humans.
- We believe that messengers were men Allah chose to guide people to Allah.
- The messengers guided people towards good and warned against evil.
- We believe that the Messengers were like all people. They ate, slept, went to the market and had family.
- We believe that the Messengers did not know the Unseen.

4. Belief in the Messengers

Messengers of Determination

- Allah sent many Messengers to people but there are 5 messengers who Allah chose to be special.
- These messengers are special because their people were too many and they worked very hard to tell them about Allah.
- These 5 messengers were very patient with their people and kept reminding them about Allah and to follow His Command.
- These messengers were
 - Nuh (peace be upon him)
 - Ibrahim (peace be upon him)
 - Musa (peace be upon him)
 - Eisa (peace be upon him)
 - Muhammad ﷺ
- Muhammad ﷺ is the leader among them all.

4. Belief in the Messengers

Mohammed ﷺ

- We believe Prophet Muhammad ﷺ is the last messenger Allah sent. There will be no messengers after him.
- We believe that he is the leader of all messengers and the best human being.
- The Qur'an was sent down on Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.
- Allah told us to follow the Sunnah of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.
- Whenever we say or hear the name of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ, we should say 'sallallahu alaihi wa salam' which means 'Peace and blessing of Allah be upon him'.

5. Belief in the Last Day

- We believe Allah will bring us back to life after death.
- We believe everybody will stand in front of Allah on the Last Day.
- We believe it is the Day when Allah will ask us about our good deeds and bad deeds.
- We believe it is the Day when Allah will reward us for our good deeds and punish for the bad deeds.

6. Belief in the Decree



- We believe Allah wrote all the decrees in the Preserved Tablet.
- We believe everything happens because Allah allowed it to happen.
- We believe Allah knows everything about what happened before, what is happening now and what will happen later.
- Allah knew about us and what we will do even before we were born.

أركان الإسلام

Pillars of Islam

وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ ﴿٥٦﴾

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

Pillars of Islam

Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: Islam is based on (the following) five (principles):

1. To testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah and Muhammad is Allah's Messenger (ﷺ).
 2. To offer the (compulsory congregational) prayers dutifully and perfectly.
 3. To pay Zakat (i.e. obligatory charity) .
 4. To perform Hajj. (i.e. Pilgrimage to Mecca)
 5. To observe fast during the month of Ramadan. (Al Bukhari 8)
- The pillars of Islam are basic rules that every Muslim should follow.
 - The job of a pillar is to support or hold something up. The Pillars of Islam support and hold up our religion of Islam.
 - The Pillars of Islam are five.
 - The meaning of Islam is to surrender to Allah with

Tawheed, to submit to Him with obedience, and to free oneself from shirk and its people.

- **We need all five pillars of Islam to be a complete Muslim.**

First Pillar: Two Testimonies

وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ ﴿٥٦﴾

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

1. Ash hadu an la ilaha ila Allah

- I testify there is no one worthy of worship except Allah

2. Wa ash hadu ana Muhammadan Rasool Allah

- And I testify that Mohammed is the Messenger of Allah

The one who says the shahadatain enters Islam.

Closer look at:

Ash hadu an la ilaha ila Allah

I testify there is no one worthy of worship except Allah.

- We do not worship anything except Allah.

- Worshipping anything besides Allah is called “shirk”. This is the worst thing a person can do.
- We do not worship the sun, moon, stars, or people because doing this is shirk. Allah made the sun, moon, stars and people.
- We only worship Allah.

Closer look at:

Wa ana Muhammadan Rasool Allah

Mohammed is the Messenger of Allah.

- The second part of the shahadatain is to testify Mohammed (ﷺ) is the Messenger of Allah.
- We obey him in whatever he commanded.
- We stay away from whatever he told us to stay away from.
- We believe what he told us is the truth. His sayings are called “hadith”.
- We worship Allah in the way he told us. This is called following the “Sunnah”.

- Whenever we say or hear the name of Prophet Muhammad, we should follow it with **صلى الله عليه و سلم** (Peace and Blessings of Allah be upon Him)

Second Pillar: Establishing the Prayers

﴿٥٦﴾ وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

- The prayer in Arabic is called “salat” which means connection. When we pray, we are connecting with Allah.
- Muslims pray five times a day. It is important to always remember Allah.
- The names and times of the prayer are:
 1. Fajr: before sunrise
 2. Dhuhur: noon time
 3. ‘Asr: afternoon
 4. Maghrib: sunset
 5. ‘Isha: night time
- The prayer timings change every day in every place.
- All Muslims pray in the direction of the Ka’aba which is in Makkah.
- The “masjid” is the place where Muslims pray.

- The call to prayer is called the “adhaan”. It is something which people can hear.
- Before praying, a person performs “wudhu” which is to clean ourselves in the way the Prophet (ﷺ) taught us.

Third Pillar: Give Zakat

﴿٥٦﴾ وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

- Allah has ordered Muslims to pay Zakat which is taken from the rich and given to the poor.
- Zakat is given once a year and for every 100 dirhams, 2.5 dirhams is taken as Zakat.
- We are one ummah and we should show kindness, love and mercy to one another.
- When we give Zakat to the poor, it purifies and cleanses wealth, and purifies us from stinginess and miserliness.
- It increases the love between the rich and poor, takes away hatred, brings security and happiness to the Ummah.

Fourth Pillar: Fasting Ramadan

وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ ﴿٥٦﴾

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

- Fasting is to give up food and drink during the day.
- Each day during the month of Ramadan, Muslims fast.
- Fasting helps a Muslim to get closer to Allah.
- It also helps a Muslim to stay away from the things Allah does not like and has told us to avoid. This is known as Taqwa.
- Taqwa is to do opposite our desires. Taqwa is to choose what Allah loves over what He forbade us.
- Fasting also helps Muslims compete to do more good deeds.

Fifth Pillar: Hajj

وَمَا خَلَقْتُ الْجِنَّ وَالْإِنْسَ إِلَّا لِيَعْبُدُونِ ﴿٥٦﴾

And I (Allah) created not the jinns and humans except they should worship Me (Alone). (Adh-Dhariyat:56)

- Hajj is one of the greatest acts of worship.
- It is the last pillar of Islam.
- Hajj is a journey to the Ka'abah that every Muslim must make at least once in his life, if he is able to do so.
- Hajj like all other acts of worship should be done only for Allah and following the way of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.
- Each year, millions of Muslims go to Makkah to perform Hajj.
- The time of Hajj is in the month of Dhul Hijjah.
- Allah forgives all the sins of the one who goes to perform Hajj and makes them enter paradise.

أركان الإحسان

Pillars of Ihsan

To worship Allah as If you see Him and If you cannot see Him then know He sees you.

وَأَحْسِنُوا إِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ الْمُحْسِنِينَ

And do Ihsan, Truly, Allah loves Al-Muhsineen (the good-doers).
(Al Baqarah:195)

- Ihsan is to do something well, perfectly and sincerely for Allah.
- Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said: “Ihsan means worshipping Allah as if you can see Him, and although you cannot see Him, He can see you.”
- People who do ihsan are called Muhsineen and Allah loves them.
- Allah wrote ihsan on everything.
 - A person does ihsan to Allah by tawheed and not committing shirk.
 - A person does ihsan to the Prophet (ﷺ) by following his sunnah.
 - A person does ihsan to his parents by caring for them.

- A person does ihsan to his family and relatives by connecting with them and asking about them.
- A person does ihsan to others by not hurting them with his hand or tongue.

شروط لا اله الا الله
Conditions of (لا اله الا الله)

There are seven conditions to (لا اله الا الله). This means our (لا اله الا الله) will not be complete if we do not have these seven matters.

I. Knowledge (العلم)

- I know there is no ilah but Allah.
- I know there is no creator but Allah.
- I know the One Who sees me, hears me and knows about me is Allah.
- I know the One Who will bring me back to life is Allah.

2. Certainty (اليقين)

- I am certain there is no ilah but Allah because only He is perfect.
- I am certain Allah is above the seven heavens because He is Al 'Ala - The Most High.
- I am certain there is no creator but Allah.
- I am certain Allah will bring me back to life because He promised there will be paradise for the one who believes in Him and does good. He will have a better life than this one.

3. Acceptance (القبول)

- I accept all that Allah says is true.
- I accept when Allah tells us something is good then it is good such as believing in Him and being good to the parents.
- I accept when Allah tells us something is bad then it is bad such as lying and stealing.

4. Submission (الانقياد)

- I submit to Allah by doing what He says such as praying five times a day.
- I submit to Allah by staying away from what He told us such as lying.
- I submit to Allah by being good to my parents and helping others.

5. Truthful (الصدق)

- Before I do anything, I am truthful that I am doing it for Allah.
- Before I pray, I am truthful to do it for Allah and not for others.
- Before being good to others, I am truthful I do it for Allah and not for others.

6. Sincerity (الإخلاص)

- While I am doing my work, I am sincere and do it only for Allah, and not so others will say, “you are so good”.
- While I give water and seeds to the birds, I am sincere to do it only for Allah and not so others can see me and say, “you are so good”.
- While I read the Qur’an, I am sincere and do it only for Allah, and not so others will say, “he knows so much”.

7. Love (المحبة)

- When I do anything for Allah, I do it because I love Allah.
- When I read Qur'an, I do it because I love Allah.
- When I listen to my parents and teachers, I do it because I love Allah.
- When I learn, listen and do my homework, I do it because I love Allah.
- Allah gave me many things and He is taking care of me every moment. I love Allah because He is One, perfect and no one is like Him.

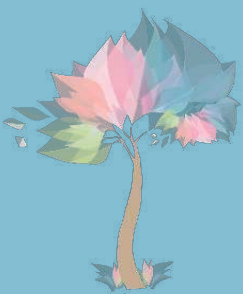
